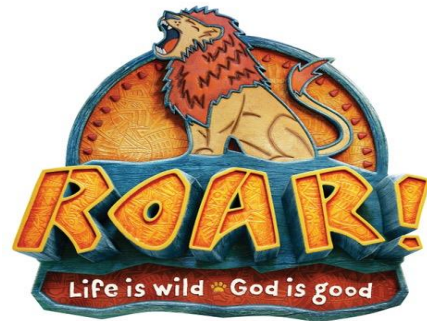

The Outreach Team is sponsoring a food bank collection during the month of July. There will be a collection table in the lobby. Please watch the bulletin announcements for a list of items needed.

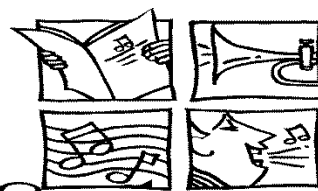

## **STAFF TRANSITION**

The PPRC (Pastor Parish Relations Committee) and Pastor Tom would like to thank Seth Jacoby for his five months of service as the Director of Worship and Music Ministries. Seth has decided to take another position at a church in Ephrata where he will be more involved in the traditional service that has several bell choirs as well as helping with other traditional elements. As a result Seth will no longer be serving as CUMC's Director of Worship and Music Ministries, but will continue to serve as a part time organist and choir director for the 11:00 AM service as the service does not conflict with his other position. In the meantime PPRC has decided to revert to three positions (Praise Director, Choir Director and Organist) to allow for maximum flexibility. In the interim Kathie Ingoglia will be filling in as the Interim Praise Director for the 9:00 AM Service. Steve Wenzel will continue to play twice a month as well. We wish Seth the best of luck in his new position and look forward to continuing our relationship with him.

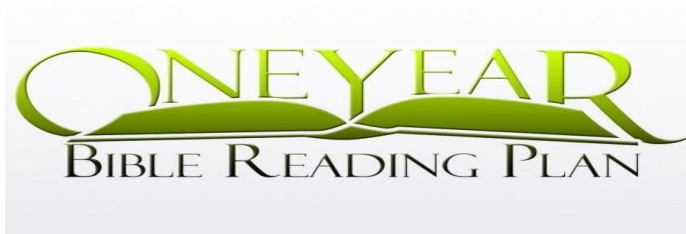
