



STAFF TRANSITION

The PPRC (Pastor Parish Relations Committee) and Pastor Tom would like to thank Seth Jacoby for his five months of service as the Director of Worship and Music Ministries. Seth has decided to take another position at a church in Ephrata where he will be more involved in the traditional service that has several bell choirs as well as helping with other traditional elements.
